TITLE:	DRA 20S								
PREREQUISITES:	Course none. Students should have patience and enjoy working at things involving careful precision and detail. Should possess a willingness to produce neat, organized work.								
DESCRIPTION:	The student learns professional drawing methods and the correct judgement of proportion, as well as the proper use of drawing instruments. Exercises focus on perspective drawing by mechanical as well as digital means. Exercises develop the ability to visualize, or think in three dimensions, and to produce drawings that are clear, accurate, and complete. After the student can draw complex geometric forms with confidence, the principles of figure drawing are introduced. Students quickly learn to produce accurate perspective drawings and realistic figure drawings. Animation and cartooning is introduced with the completion of a digital animated movie.								
DURATION:	The course lasts one term.								
GENERAL OBJECTIVES:	Upon successful completion of the course the student should be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. properly use and care for technical drawing instruments2. think in three dimensions, visualize objects in different views and imagine objects reduced to simple geometric shapes3. accurately render basic forms in perspective with skill, speed and neatness4. render the human figure realistically and expressively5.
